## **Residential – Long Term Program**

Origami Brain Injury Rehabilitation Center is a 16 bed, residential facility on 34 acres of land in rural Mason, Michigan. We strive to enhance quality of life and the standard of care for those individuals who most benefit from a structured and supervised environment in a quiet supportive and home-like setting where many community resources are nearby and regularly utilized.

### **Program Admission Criteria:**

Male or Female 18 years or older

Requires 24 hours structured support in the functional area: Independent Living

Requires assistance in any of the following Focus Areas:

- Self-Care
- Safety
- Learning
- Leisure
- Productivity
- Community Access
- Self-Direction/Initiation
- Social Skills
- Communication

Capable of transferring self with no more than moderate assistance

Medically stable, free from acute infection or fever

Does not require daily skilled nursing

Minimum Ranchos Los Amigos Level of 4/5

Can participate in a minimum of 6 hours of programming per day

Not a danger to self or others

Not actively engaged in substance abuse



### **Program Focus:**

Maximize independence in all activities of daily living (basic and advanced)

Provide vocational and avocational opportunities

Support social interactions and involvement in the community

Individualized reward programs to help shape and reinforce positive behavior

Enrich quality of life and active participation

Ongoing stakeholder education and support

### **Levels of Care:**

Standard – moderate assistance in functional areas: Self Care, Safety, and Independent Living

Intensive – maximum assistance in functional areas: Self Care, Safety, and Independent Living

Respite – Short-term care

### **Additional Services:**

- Individual Therapy
- Group Therapy
- Evening & Daily Social Activities
- Supported Outings & Vacations
- Supported Employment

### **Program Discharge Criteria:**

1. Individual's behavior is not compatible with the program goals, group activities, or may prevent the progress of other participants\*
2. Poses a risk or danger to self or others\*

\*A discharge procedure will be followed ensuring the opportunity to access other appropriate resources
