Semi Independent Living Program

Individualized treatment plans are established upon admission clearly defining rehabilitation goals and potential discharge plans. All programming integrates the Hierarchy of Neuropsychological Functions, a progressive hierarchy of cognitive skills that build upon each other in a manner that facilitates efficient progress. The treatment team utilizes the approach to ensure proper coordination of all therapies.

Program Admission Criteria:

Male or Female 18 years or older (ages 16-17 may be admitted with special consideration)

Requires 5 hours or less of daily support in any of the following functional areas:

Capable of transferring self with no more than modified independence

Medically stable, free from acute infection or fever

Does not require daily skilled nursing

Engaged in or actively pursuing productive activity including, but not limited to: work, school, vocational/avocational activity, or extensive rehabilitation.

Not a danger to self or others

Not actively engaged in substance abuse

Program Focus:

Supported, semi independent living

Establish and foster maximum independence in all areas of daily living

Provide guidance for vocational or avocational goals

Facilitate healthy social interaction and involvement in the community

Ongoing stakeholder education and support

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Program Discharge Criteria:

1. Treatment team's assessment indicates that the individual has achieved a level of functional independence requiring less than daily support. functional areas: Self Care, Safety, and Independent Living
2. Individual's behavior is not compatible with the program goals, group activities, or may prevent the progress of other participants*
3. Poses a risk or danger to self or others*
