#### **OVERVIEW**

Under this program, Medicaid covers post-acute, comprehensive, intensive, goal-directed residential and outpatient rehabilitation services for individuals who have experienced a moderate or severe acquired brain injury such as traumatic brain injury, stroke, etc.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible for the BIS Medicaid Program, an individual must meet the following criteria\*:

- At least 21 years old.
- Medicaid-eligible.
- Have a qualifying brain injury that occurred within 15 months of application to the BIS Medicaid Program.
- Medically stable.
- Able to participate in appropriate residential services, which includes at least fifteen (15) hours per week or appropriate outpatient services, which includes at least nine (9) hours per week upon approval for the BIS Medicaid Program.
- Appropriate for 60 to 90 days of BIS Medicaid Program as supported by a Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PMR) physician's order.
- In the absence of a PMR physician's order, a psychological consultation conducted by a qualified professional that substantiates the beneficiary's ability to interact with the therapy treatment team and the ability to participate in the required therapy levels will be accepted.
- \*The above is reflective of general eligibility guidelines. Final determinations and authorizations will be made by MDHHS.
