## Admission Demographics

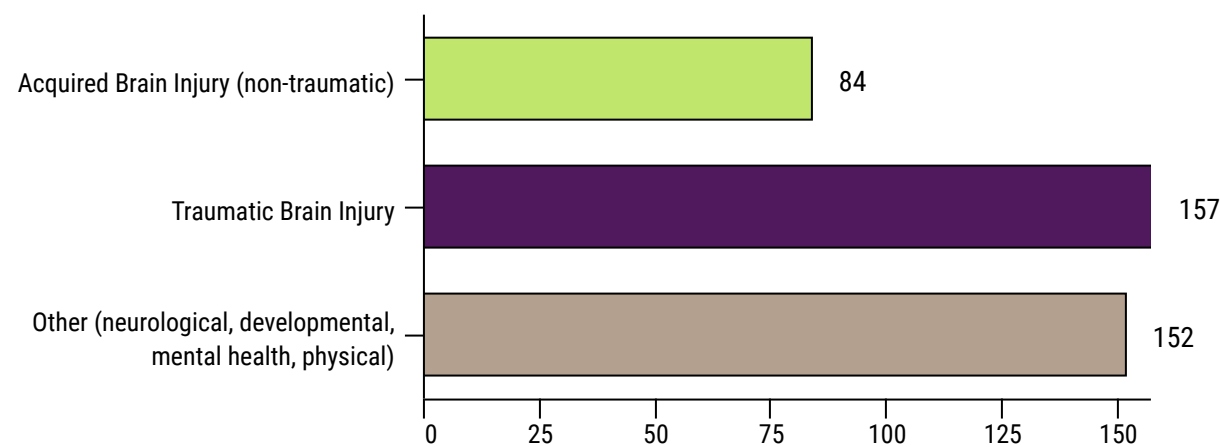
### Outpatient Program: 393

**Average Hours of Treatment per Day (Residential Short-Term):** 3 (n=11)

**Average Number of Sessions per Service (Outpatient Program):** 22

**Unexpected Transfers to Acute Care:** 10
