
ABOUT US

Our trained occupational and physical therapists collaborate with optometrists, ophthalmologists, and neuro-visual optometrists to create personalized treatment plans and exercises targeting dizziness, hand-eye coordination, visual motor integration, double vision, headaches, visual processing deficiencies, and more.
