



## SCOPE OF PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

<b>Program</b> Hours of operation	<b>Residential Program</b> Program provides services up to 24 hours per day, 7 days per week in a homelike environment. Lengths of stay vary from respite care, short term rehab, and long term support.			<b>Outpatient Program</b> Monday-Friday 7:00am – 6:00pm (varies based on individual needs)

<b>Diagnosis and Medical Status</b>	Stable, free from acute infection or fever, non-ventilator dependent, and require no advanced medical care Diagnoses may include neurological, developmental, mental health, and orthopedic conditions. Level of care, funding availability, and other considerations determine appropriateness for and type of program and services. Specific etiology, injury level, completeness, and co-morbidities as it pertains to spinal cord injuries are delineated based on the individual's ability to meet the program's admission criteria.
