What Is Vision Therapy and NVPT?

Vision therapy addresses visual-motor and/or visual-perceptual-cognitive deficits by improving the brain's ability to control eye focusing, eye movements teaming, eye tracking, and/or visual processing.

Neuro-Visual Postural Therapy (NVPT) addresses spatial visual processing dysfunction and its relationship to the proprioceptive base of support, improving the overall visual system, executive processing, balance, and posture.

Origami's specially trained occupational and physical therapists work with Neuro-Visual Optometrists to establish individualized treatment plans and exercise regimens to address:

- Ocular Motor Dysfunction (pursuit and saccadic)
- Accommodative Dysfunction (focusing)
- Amblyopia (lazy eye)
- Strabismus
- Convergence Insufficiency / Convergence Excess
- Visual Processing Deficiencies
- Headaches
- Suppression
- Double Vision
- Visual Motor Integration
- Hand Eye Coordination
- Dizziness
